Planetarium Fund – Flex 70 receives Lipper award

Two awards at once. This honour goes to the Planetarium Fund – Flex 70, one of the family of funds at PKB Privatbank, a Lugano-based bank specialising in asset management.

Lipper Italy named the fund **best fund over 5 years** and **best fund over 3 years** in the "Mixed Assets EUR Conservative – Europe" category.

Flex 70 is a sub-fund of the Planetarium Fund managed by Rolf Spannagel, a PKB Privatbank manager specialising in European equities.

The Planetarium Fund is a SICAV under Luxembourg law with EUR 450 million in assets, comprised of 11 sub-funds managed by PKB Privatbank and a further four sub-funds managed by Anthilia Sgr (a fund management company headquartered in Milan, approximately 40% of which is held by PKB Group). The various funds cover a broad range of asset classes: from equity and bond funds to flexible and total return funds.

In addition to Flex 70, the Planetarium Fund – Riverfield Equities sub-fund has received several awards in the past for its excellent returns.

We would also like to call your attention to the fact that the Planetarium offering was expanded in 2009 to include four more new sub-funds: Fundamental European Selection, Quant American Selection, Riverfield Real Assets and Riverfield AllRounder.
